h = Heard considerably more often than seen.

w = Winter Migrants from North America, mainly Sept-May.

b = Breeding Migrants from South America, mainly March-Sept.

p = Passage Migrants, mainly from March-May and Sept-Nov.

d = Mainly in dry season, Dec-March.

r = Mainly in rainy season, April-Sept.
