Packing list for Rancho Naturalista

Binoculars (most important)
Rubber boots (for mud) You may want to bring old tennis shoes or boots and then just leave them behind when you leave, that way you won't have to worry about cleaning them.
Raincoat
Umbrella
Insect repellent or Citronella oil (for insects- it's expensive in Costa Rica) Small alarm clock NATURALISTA
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Shampoo and conditioner
Toothbrush and toothpaste (don't forget you might need this!)
Smart phone or tablet (in case you want to use the Wi-Fi here at the lodge to stay in touch)
A light sweater for the cool nights
A warm coat if you are going to the highlands to see the Quetzals or to the Volcano. (It gets cold up there)
A flashlight for night walks
Camera (a good choice)
A small backpack to carry things on the trail and at the airport
Sunscreen and a Bandana or a hat for sun
A Swimsuit if you plan to go whitewater rafting or just in case
A good book to read during the siesta hour after lunch or in the evening is a good idea! We have no television here at the lodge.
